



The New Veteran's Cemetery- Preston, MN

The progress continues in Preston, and it is anticipated to be open November 11, 2015.

Preston will be the second Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery, with Redwood Falls and Duluth to follow.

With Preston and the additional locations, a State Veterans Cemetery should be located within 75 miles of most Minnesotans, reducing the distance needed to travel to visit loved ones interred.




Aerial View of Preston from October 2014
